
## NAM Collection 2023 Part II List of Works

## Thursday, May 18th - Tuesday, July 25th

The number of works does not necessarily correspond to the order in which they will be exhibited due to the configuration of the exhibition space. The temperature, humidity, and illumination in the exhibition rooms are adjusted to a suitable environment for the protection of the works.

The NAM Collection 2023 Part II will feature works by artists who traveled to the West between the Meiji and Showa era, with a focus on artists with local connections, such as Nakamura Fusetsu, who spent his youth in Takato, Shinshu, and whose death this year marks 80 years since his death, and Hayashi Shizue, who was born in present-day Ueda. The influence of Western artistic expression on Japanese modern art is immeasurable. In particular, painters and sculptors who traveled to the West worked hard to acquire skills by visiting local art schools and artists. This exhibition explores the relationship between these influences by displaying works from each artist's period of travel to Europe, as well as works created after their return to Japan, which deepened as a result of their Western experience. In addition, the special exhibition "In the Genes, Taking Marvelous Meiji Craftsmanship into the Future" (~6/18) and "Katsushika Hokusai and the Three 'Shinano': Obuse, Suwa, and Matsumoto" (7/1-8/27), which will be held at the same time, will feature "*shin-hanga* (new prints)," which were developed to revive traditional woodblock printing and to create new works. *Shin-hanga*, which are produced under the division of labor, require advanced techniques in the engraving and printing processes. We hope you will enjoy the exquisite world of color wood-block prints and the techniques that give birth to this art form.
